How many days are there in the Easter Season?

There are 50 days in the Season of Easter, which begins on the celebration of Easter and ends with the Solemnity of Pentecost. Easter is also called *Paschal Sunday* or *Resurrection Sunday*.



What is the significance of Easter in the Catholic faith?

The annual celebration of Easter holds profound significance for Catholics as it commemorates Christ's victory over sin, and death. It celebrates his Paschal Sacrifice on Calvary. Easter offers a renewed hope for Catholics, for those being baptized, and for those who are converting and being welcomed into the Catholic Church during the Easter Vigil.

What is the background for some of the popular traditions of Easter?

The most popular of the symbols of Easter for children is the Easter Bunny. Easter comes in the Springtime and the bunny represents fertility and new life. This idea has an origin that dates back to the ancient Egyptians and Greeks. The Easter Bunny then followed German immigrants to the American colonies in the 18th century, and the folklore spread across the United States, where it became a mainstay in Easter morning for many religious and nonreligious families alike.

And what about the colored eggs and egg hunts?

Did you know that the use of eggs was once forbidden during Lent? After being away, they were brought to the table on Easter, colored red to symbolize Easter joy! This custom is found not only in the Latin Church but in the Eastern Church as well. The egg is also seen as an emblem of the germinating life of early Spring. In some countries, Sponsors and Godparents give Easter eggs to their Godchildren. Here in the United States, colored eggs are used by children at Easter in some parts of the country for a game known as "egg picking" in which eggs are tapped together. Another practice is the "egg rolling" of Easter Eggs by children on Easter Monday on the lawn of the White House in Washington, DC. Still another fun use of eggs celebrated by many is the traditional Easter Egg Hunt. Egg hunts are typically not done with real eggs, of course, but rather with plastic eggs filled with all kinds of treats that are hidden and must be found. Such fun with eggs! Who would ever have thought eggs could be so much fun?
