

Novena to OUR LADY OF KNOCK



The Story of Knock

At about 8 o'clock on the Thursday evening of the 21st of August, 1879, the Blessed Virgin Mary, St. Joseph and St. John the Evangelist appeared at the South gable of the Church at Knock, County Mayo, Ireland. Beside them and a little to the right was an altar with a cross and the figure of a lamb, around which angels hovered. There were fifteen official witnesses to the apparition – young and old – who watched it for two hours in pouring rain and recited the Rosary. Two Commissions of Enquiry accepted their testimony as trustworthy and satisfactory in 1879 and 1936. Knock has been honoured by the visit of Pope John Paul II in 1979 and Pope Francis in 2018. Knock Shrine was elevated to the status of International Eucharistic and Marian Shrine by Pope Francis in 2021.

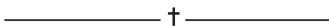

The National Public Novena takes place each year at Knock Shrine from the 13th to the 21st of August. Prayer leaflets can be obtained in any of the Shrine Offices. Two sessions are held daily, namely at 3.00pm and 8.00pm. Both sessions commence with Concelebrated Mass in the Basilica which is followed by a procession to the Apparition Gable. A procession of the Blessed Sacrament is held in the afternoon and the beautiful candlelight procession takes place at night.

For those who cannot be present, the Novena may be made at home or in the local Church. This gives them a share in the Masses and prayers being offered each day at the Shrine.
